Please note, it is the Patient's responsibility to find out from Immigration NZ what tests are required. People's requirements differ so we cannot advise you on this.

What you need to bring:

- Passport (for photographic ID and passport number)
- Prescription eyewear if you use them (glasses or contact lenses)
- Medication list and/or medical specialist reports

Fees: *

Consultation:** \$215(18yrs & over)
 \$180(Students & under 18yrs old)
X-ray: \$150
Laboratory charges: \$155(standard tests only)***

- * Please note, due to the time required to set-up an eMedical, if you cancel your appointment, there is a non-refundable fee of \$50 for each applicant.
- ** Follow up appointments may be required for abnormal results. Charges may apply.
- *** Extra laboratory tests may need to be ordered if there are abnormal blood results. This is required by New Zealand Immigration Services. Each additional laboratory test attracts a charge.

What you need to do:

- Drink plenty of water before you come in. A urine sample is required on examination.
- Please arrive 15 minutes early to your appointment as you may need to fill in forms beforehand if you are a new patient or if you need passport photos taken.
- You will need to allow up to 1.5 hours for the appointment and an extra 30 minutes for each additional family member.

Immigration will ask you for your NZER number to link with your application.
